# WABASH COUNTY YMCA EUCHRE HOUSE RULES

## 1. MAX HANDS/TIMED ROUNDS

Teams play a maximum of 15 minutes OR until one team scores at least 10 points.

Example: If a team has 7 points and then successfully plays a loner (worth 4 points) on the next hand, the game STOPS and that team records 11 points on their scorecard, since at least 10 points were reached.

## 2. DEAL/CUT

Player who receives the FIRST JACK deals. Always offer cut to the RIGHT.

## 3. MISDEAL

A misdeal may be re-dealt. Do NOT pass deal.

## 4. "STICK THE DEALER" rules APPLY

Dealer MUST call a suit upon second pass. If cards are thrown (and mucked) without dealer calling, opposing team receives 2 points, and hand is re-dealt.

## 5. "A CARD LAID IS A CARD PLAYED"

## 6. ALL HANDS PLAYED

Players MUST play with dealt cards, regardless of trump, all 9s and 10s, etc.

## 7. NO PEEKING

Keep raked tricks face down. EXCEPTION: Cards may be turned over to answer questions regarding a renege.

## 8. "WINNERS WALK"

Winners rotate to the next table and must partner with a different player. Do NOT partner with any player more than once.

TIE: Teams draw high card. High card moves.

## 9. SCORING

The first team that reaches a score of at least 10 points wins the game. The game stops and points are recorded. Note: A total of 13 points per game is possible.

Example: If a team has 9 points and then successfully plays a loner (worth 4 points) on the next hand, that team records a final score of 13 points.

## 10. WINNERS

- Highest scorer earns bragging rights and 2 bonus door-prize tickets.
- Lowest scorer gets a box of tissues to go home and "cry about it" (just for laughs). If you prefer not to be recognized for lowest score, do not turn in your scorecard.
- Two individuals receive a \$20 value door-prize, courtesy of Autumn Ridge Rehabilitation Center.
